Setlist Edit Mode

Setlists

Click to rename your Setlist





Use menu items or **All Setlists** buttons to remove, add or duplicate your Setlists.



All LiveSets

Drag and drop Ableton LiveSets into the **All LiveSets** table. Program Change messages will be assigned automatically.




Click to globally reassign the launch Program Change messages associated with each LiveSet. You will be alerted if the message is already assigned to another LiveSet.

Use menu items or delete buttons to remove selected LiveSets across all Setlists.

The **All LiveSets** search box will help find specific LiveSets








All LiveSets delete Button and Search Box

Current Setlist

Drag Ableton files from **All LiveSets** to create your Setlists. Drag and drop to edit each Setlist.



Use menu items or **Current Setlist** buttons to remove LiveSets from your **Current Setlist**, or go to the selected LiveSet.




Current Setlist Menu



Current Setlist Buttons

Drag Ableton files directly from Finder onto your **Current Setlist** to Globally reassign the associated Ableton file across all Setlists.



Performance Mode



The current Setlist is locked and ready for performance.

Use the keyboard right arrow key in addition to the up/down arrow buttons to launch the selected LiveSet.

Please Note: If using an external MIDI device, specific Program Change messages can be sent in on the selected MIDI port to launch the corresponding LiveSet in the current Setlist. This is in addition to next song auto-load via the Virtual MIDI Port.

Preferences

Ensure the 'Use Virtual Port' box is ticked for the 'OnStageLive Pro Virtual Port' to appear as a MIDI destination in Ableton Live.

Use Program Change 128 in a MIDI clip or at the end of each song for next song auto-load. The App 'active' switch allows selection of the correct Virtual Port without changing Projects.
